HEARD: the removal of the article “Other positron emission tomography/computed tomography tracers in differential thyroid carcinoma beyond the use of 2-[¹⁸F] FDG” from the journal "Problems of Endocrine Pathology", Volume 79, No. 3 (2022) due to the violation by the authors M. Acuña Hernandez, P. Vallejo Armenta, U. Cancino Ramos, L. Sanchez Orduz, P. Casanova Triviño, L. Cadavid Blanco of publishing ethics and the requirements for submitting a manuscript to the journal "Problems of Endocrine Pathology".

According to the principles developed by the Committee on Publishing Ethics (COPE) and the Author's Declaration and Guarantees indicated on the journal's website, when submitting any research article for publication in the Journal, authors must confirm and guarantee that: The research article is original, has not been published in any other journal (medical or otherwise) or is not currently under consideration for publication by another journal, and does not infringe any existing copyright or any other legal rights. The authors of the article “Other positron emission tomography/computed tomography tracers in differential thyroid carcinoma beyond the use of 2-[¹⁸F] FDG” M. Acuña Hernandez, P. Vallejo Armenta, U. Cancino Ramos, L. Sanchez Orduz, P. Casanova Triviño, L. Cadavid Blanco violated this requirement when submitting the article for publication.

Also, according to the "Code of Academic Integrity of the State Institution “V. Danilevsky Institute for Endocrine Pathology Problems of the National Academy of Medical Sciences of Ukraine”” publicizing (in part or in full) one's own previously published scientific results as new scientific results is self-plagiarism.

The authors violated ethical standards by not notifying the journal editors that the article in another journal was accepted for publication on March 4, 2022, and later published Revista Argentina de Endocrinología y Metabolismo [ISSN 0326-4610](https://doi.org/10.1007/s00525-022-05920-2); v. 59(2); p. 6-12; https://raem.org.ar/articulos_raem/trazadores-pet-ct-en-carcinoma-diferenciado-de-tiroides-mas-alla-del-uso-del-2-18ffdg-pet-ct/).

It was established that this was not an honest mistake of the collective authorship, but a deliberate misleading of the editors of the journal "Problems of Endocrine Pathology", because the contact person for editorial correspondence in both cases was the same - M. Acuña Hernandez, who indicated the same e-mail for contacts nandu152@hotmail.com

Cadavid Blanco submitting the manuscript for review to the journal "Problems of Endocrine Pathology", but with the mandatory duplication of the electronic submission with a paper copy, sent by mail to the editorial office, including declarations of compliance with ethical standards with personal signatures of all authors.
