#### **Meeting of the Academic Council of the SI “V. Danilevsky Institute for Endocrine Pathology Problems of the National Academy of Medical Sciences of Ukraine”**

**November 11, 2022**

**HEARD:** the removal of the article “Other positron emission tomography/computed tomography tracers in differential thyroid carcinoma beyond the use of 2-[18F] FDG” from the journal "Problems of Endocrine Pathology", Volume 79, No. 3 (2022) due to the violation by the authors M. Acuña Hernandez, P. Vallejo Armenta, U. Cancino Ramos, L. Sanchez Orduz, P. Casanova Triviño, L. Cadavid Blanco of publishing ethics and the requirements for submitting a manuscript to the journal "Problems of Endocrine Pathology".

#### **ADOPTED:**

1. Recommend to the Academic Council of the State Institution “V. Danilevsky Institute for Endocrine Pathology Problems of the National Academy of Medical Sciences of Ukraine» to withdraw the article M. Acuña Hernandez, P. Vallejo Armenta, U. Cancino Ramos, L. Sanchez Orduz, P. Casanova Triviño, L. Cadavid Blanco “Other positron emission tomography/computed tomography tracers in differential thyroid carcinoma beyond the use of 2-[18F] FDG” from the journal Problems of Endocrine Pathology 2022;79(3): 81-89, expenses to be paid by the editorial office.

2. The date of retraction (withdrawal) of the article shall be considered the date of adoption by the Academic Council of the State Institution “V. Danilevsky Institute for Endocrine Pathology Problems of the National Academy of Medical Sciences of Ukraine» the final decision on withdrawal of the article.

3. The department of scientific information and patent-licensing work should send information about the retraction of the scientific article to the scientific and metric databases in which the journal is indexed.

4. The editorial staff of the journal:

a) notifies the contact person for editorial correspondence M. Acuña Hernandez, [nandu152@hotmail.com](mailto:nandu152@hotmail.com), about the retraction of the article with justification of the reasons;


b) in the next issue of the journal, it prints information about the retraction of the article, in which it notes: reasons and grounds for retraction, so that readers can understand why the article is unreliable, as well as who retracts the article;

c) on the website, in compliance with the norms of correctness, corrects the archive number of the journal in which the article was published, "Problems of Endocrine Pathology", Volume 79, No. 3 (2022), where: the title of the article and the author(s) remain with the mark "article retracted" and publishes who retracts the article, the reason and grounds for the retraction;

d) taking into account that the main purpose of the retraction is to correct the literature and ensure its integrity, and not to punish the authors, in the future, do not object to the authors M. Acuña Hernandez, P. Vallejo Armenta, U. Cancino Ramos, L. Sanchez Orduz, P. Casanova Triviño, L. Cadavid Blanco submitting the manuscript for review to the journal "Problems of Endocrine Pathology", but with the mandatory duplication of the electronic submission with a paper copy, sent by mail to the editorial office, including declarations of compliance with ethical standards with personal signatures of all authors.
